Thank you for your interest in enrolling your child in the Wakonda Preschool Program. Our program is sponsored by the Wakonda Christian Church. Through exposure to developmentally appropriate learning situations and tools with which to learn, we attempt to provide an atmosphere that will help your child to grow socially, physically and intellectually.

Wakonda Preschool offers classes for children ages two, three, four, and five years old. All three, four, and five year olds must be potty-trained. Below are the options to register for at each age level.

2 year olds	Wednesday a.m.	\$60 a month
3 year olds	Mon/Wed a.m.	\$105 a month
3 year olds	Tues/Thurs a.m.	\$105 a month

Pre-K I	Mon, Tues, Wed a.m.	\$120 a month
Pre-K II	Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs a.m.	\$160 a month
Pre-K I	Mon, Tues, Wed p.m.	\$120 a month
Pre-K II	Mon, Tues, Wed, Thurs p.m.	\$160 a month

All a.m. classes meet from 9:00 - 11:15 a.m.

All p.m. classes meet from 12:30 - 2:45 p.m.

A registration fee of \$90.00 must accompany the registration form for new students. Of the \$90, \$50 is non-refundable and \$40 will be credited towards your first month's tuition. A registration fee of \$80.00 is required of those students who have been previously enrolled. Of the \$80, \$40 is non-refundable and \$40 will be credited towards your first month's tuition. **After May 19, 2010 the entire registration fee is non-refundable.**

All of the Pre-K and three-year-old classes will have no more than 13 students, each with a lead teacher and an assistant teacher. The two-year-old class will have a maximum of ten students with a lead teacher and an assistant. A separate curriculum has been developed for the three-year-olds and Pre-K classes. Their curriculum includes themed units, field trips, music, art, language and math activities, a gym-time indoors and out, and of course, plenty of opportunity to learn through play! The "twos" are provided with time for socialization through play. They are offered opportunities for simple art projects, as well as a time for music, stories and gym-time.

*To guarantee placement, applications for **currently enrolled students AND siblings of currently enrolled students** must be received **NO LATER** than January 15, 2010. However, guaranteed placement is valid only until class sizes are filled. A change to our registration policy last year, is that siblings of currently enrolled students MAY register from now until January 15th to guarantee placement. After that time, enrollment will be open to new students. After January 15th, all parents will be sent a letter confirming placement as well as a physical and immunization form. If placement is not available, parents will be notified, the registration check will be returned and your child will be offered the opportunity to be placed on the waiting list.*

In early May, enrolled students will receive a packet of forms to conclude the enrollment. Those forms must be accompanied by a tuition payment and returned to the school no later than June 15. A tuition discount of 5% off the yearly balance will be given to those wanting to pay the year's balance in full by June 15.

In the weeks prior to the beginning of school, parents and their children will receive an invitation to a school Open House. During that time, families will have an opportunity to become acquainted with the child's teacher and classroom environment. Classes for the Pre-K sections, and some of the three-year-old sections will begin on Tuesday, September 7. Classes for the rest of the three-year old sections, and two-year-old classes will begin on Wednesday, September 8.
